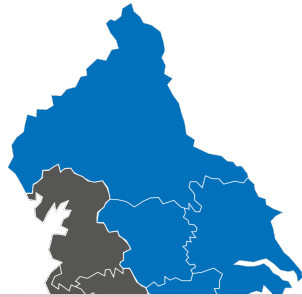
Represent the Florence Nightingale Foundation in your region by:

- Helping us to demonstrate the longer-term impact of FNF scholarship and programmes

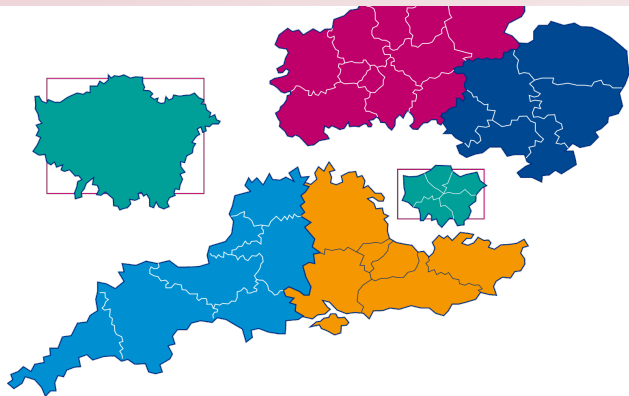

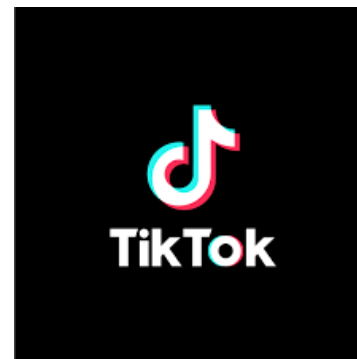
